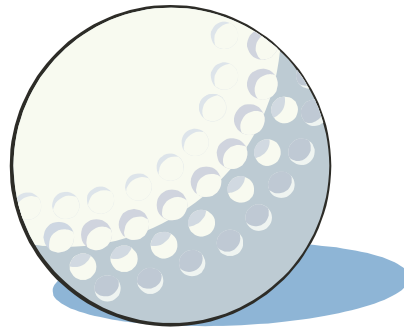

Golf League Times Explained

Someone asked me the other day, what time do the leagues play. So I decided to provide a quick article with the time.

Monday at Iron Horse (League was canceled)

Tuesday at Spring Lake: Tee times are between 4:52 and 5:22. Since the league has become smaller, the tee times had to be changed a little from years past.

Wednesday at Shoreline: Tee times are between 4:52 and 5:22. Last year, we had fewer golfers, got more this year, so we asked to start a little earlier because of a later league.

Thursday at LaVista Falls: Tee times are between 4:52 and 5:22. This league was scheduled to begin at 5:15, but because more golfers signed up than I expected, we were asked to start earlier to accommodate a later league.

Friday at Elmwood GC. Tee times are between 4:00 and 5:30. This league had always been 4:00 to 6:00, but the past few years we've had a few golfers drop out: 84 golfers this year compared to 120 golfers six years ago.
