
Thanks to everyone that played and helped make this session fun and exciting.

Softball News

Time to be thinking Fall softball as the Summer session will soon be ending.

Sunday night fall softball will start August 28th, and will be played at Kelley Field on 124th and Fort Street. There will be 7 or 8 weekly games. We normally do not play on Labor Day weekend but should be playing all other Sundays. Game start times range from 6:30 to 9:30pm.

The price to play will be \$48 (early deadline July 24th) or \$58 (late deadline August 7th) which covers the league fees, softballs, umpires fees, and a small end of season softball party. The plans are to have 6 males and 6 females on each team. With multiple teams we normally draft players on teams based on skill levels to best balance the teams for best team competition (Also a great way to meet new people).
